If the ICD-9 Codes are not showing when you use the "Tools -Services - Create ICD-10 Mappings" in Medisoft:

Have all users Exit Medisoft to run the "ClearICD10Utility".


Go to the folder named Bin –

Running the Clear ICD-10 utility

This utility clears your diagnosis table of invalid values by performing the following actions:


- Clearing the ICD-9 Code & Description where it was incorrectly copied from the Code & Description fields
- Clearing the ICD-10 Code & Description where it was incorrectly copied from the ICD-9 Code & Description fields

Double-click ClearICD10utility.exe. The Open Practice screen appears.

On the Clear ICD-10 Utility screen you will see a grid of matching codes. Notice that the values in the ICD-9 and ICD-10 columns are the same. The values in the ICD-10 column are invalid and must be cleared.

If you are on Version 19 Medisoft and you do not have the "ClearICD10Utility" program:

Then verify your version of Medisoft.

In Medisoft on each computer – click on Help – About Medisoft. Look at the Version # it should be Version 19 SP1 (19.1.3.**38**)

Note: There should be a 38 at the end!

If it is Version 19 SP1 (19.1.2.**29**) - this has a 29 at the end; Then you need the Hot Fix update for Version 19, SP-1

If you do not have the Service Pack 1 (SP-1)

Then you will need Both the Service Pack 1 (SP-1) and the Hot Fix update for Version 19,

Make sure that you have installed the Hot fix update on all computers.

When done, your Medisoft Version will be Version 19 SP1 (19.1.3.38)
